

59th Annual Sierra Madre Art Fair

The Friends of the Sierra Madre Library are preparing for the 59th Annual Art Fair. It is located in Memorial Park at Sierra Madre Boulevard and Hermosa Avenue in the charming three-square mile village of Sierra Madre. Set against the San Gabriel Mountains between Pasadena and Arcadia, it is an attraction in itself. Our downtown has a friendly mix of sidewalk cafes and shops.

This two-day, widely publicized event offers artists a chance to show and sell their work. To enhance the Fair for artists and customers you have the opportunity to demonstrate your creative techniques. Food vendors will provide a selection of ethnic foods and entertainers will perform.

Our juried Art Fair will feature approximately 85 artists displaying their own works of original conception and execution. We are well known for our superior quality with an emphasis on fine arts and skilled craftsmanship. We urge you to apply early since spaces and the number of entries in each category is limited, also a high percentage of our artists return each year.

All proceeds from this event support programs, materials and equipment for the Sierra Madre Public Library.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

1. All work must be designed and executed solely by the artist. Work that has not been juried by the Exhibits Committee will not be allowed.
2. To become an exhibitor, please send a request for an invitation by Email.
 - Please attach at least FIVE jpeg or pdf images and/or a link to a portfolio of your work.
 - Please describe the medium and technique used in your work.
 - Deadline for submissions is **April 15, 2024**.
3. There will be a **\$250.00 flat fee** for a 10' x 10' space.
4. Our policy is that the artist be present Saturday and Sunday.
5. All sales will be handled by the artist. You should bring any supplies or equipment needed to handle cash, check or credit card purchases. The artist is responsible for collection and reporting of all taxes, including 10.25% CA Sales Tax.
6. Invitations will be sent to the artist whose work has been accepted, and are not transferable. Please do not send money until you receive an invitation.
7. Invitations and acceptance to participate in the Fair are the responsibility of the Exhibits Committee only, and its decisions are final. The Exhibits Committee reserves the right to remove work from the Fair that is substantially different from photographs submitted or that is not done by the artist. Only by maintaining these qualifications can we assure the outstanding artistry and friendly feeling that the Sierra Madre Art Fair has become known for.
